Rec and KS1	A wide variety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take 10 (available in French & Spanish) • “Hocus & Lotus” (Dinocroc resource – an MFL talking text, available in 6 different languages) 	<p>Incidentals that could be taught:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Good morning/afternoon” during registration • “hot/cold lunch” • “please” & “thank you” • Counting numbers 1 – 10 • Colours <p>1 singing session a week/fortnight could be used for MFL using the “Take 10” books which include action rhymes and games (eg. “Heads, Shoulders, Knees and Toes”).</p> <p>1 story session a week/fortnight could be used learning a talking text story from “Hocus & Lotus”. (The first story in particular is very good as it is very repetitive. The children pick it up quickly.)</p>
Y3&4	Latin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimus resource 	Follow the syllabus.
Y5&6	French	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Early Start 1 & 2 • Rigolo 	Resources to be worked through in chronological order.
