

PE and Sport Provision

Funding allocated to the Partnership Schools is used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of. Here is a summary of how we have allocated the funding:

- Paying specialist football, rugby and netball coaches to help children develop skills to play against other schools.
- Paying for outdoor PE clothing
- Paying for specialist Slanted Dance and gymnastic coaches for CPD and pupil development.
- Specialist PE through Football in the Community – a charity based at Norwich City Football Club provides PPA cover. To view our schemes of work please follow the link http://www.communitysportsfoundation.org.uk/others/Partner_Schools/
- PE co-ordinator will continue to produce a portfolio to achieve a level 4 in Leadership and Management in Physical Education in primary Schools qualification- to be awarded in July 2015
- PE audit of equipment, which led to the purchase of a full range of PE equipment, is being purchased to be used by staff and specialist coaches.
- Providing cover staff to release teachers for professional development in PE and sport
- Employing specialist coaches to work alongside teachers in lesson to increase their subject knowledge and confidence
- Providing after-school sport and holiday clubs – examples include: netball, football, multi-skills, roller-skating, karate, rugby
- PE curriculum – swimming, dance, gymnastics, linking Norwich City Football Club with Maths and English
- Paying for transport, pool hire and instruction to provide additional swimming lessons for pupils unable to swim
- Providing extra, additional activities such as outdoor and adventurous activities on twice yearly residential
- Engaging the least active in a community program-Fit4it
- Quality assuring the work of sports coaches to run competitions, and increase participation in national school games competitions.
- Quality assured professional training for all class based staff to ensure 'good and outstanding' PE
- TA training for Norfolk PE teaching competence standards programme (NPETCS). Once trained, will provide specialist quality teaching in all classes and support to class.
