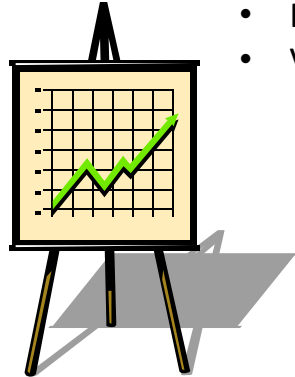


Make sure each child makes at least GOOD progress while they are at school
