The Orange Register

The children work very hard to maintain a high level of behavior; however there are times that we have a 'forgetting moment'. Our traffic lights system in school helps children to see that although they may have had one of those moments, they can always alter their behavior. Using the green, yellow, orange, red system is a very visual way of allowing children to see how they are doing. If a child repeatedly goes onto orange, there may be a different issue that we need to address with that child and family. With this

in mind we will be recording children that go onto orange in the Orange Register in order to monitor this and put in place any interventions that are needed. More information about this can be found on the schools website under the policy section in the behavior policy.
