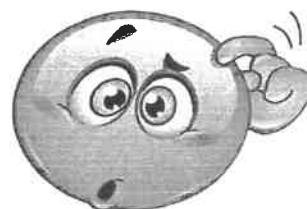
Reception Project

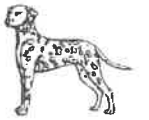

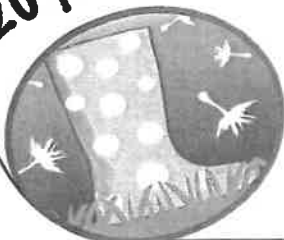

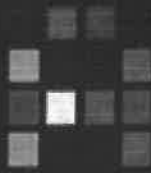
