- 13 to 16 years

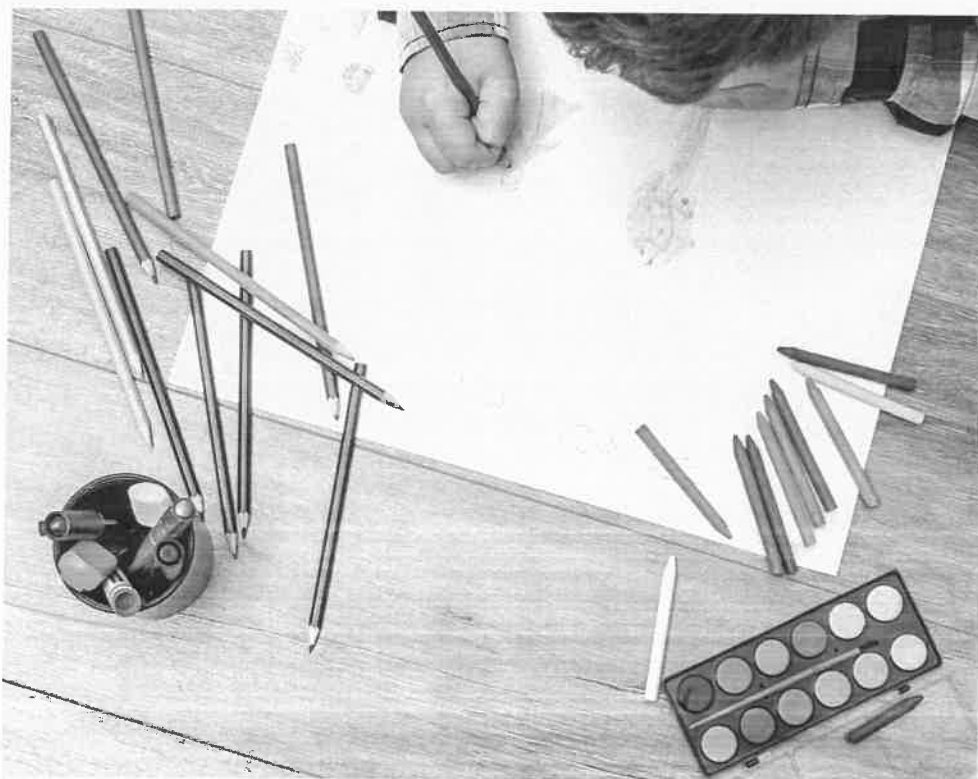
The winning entries will be framed and displayed in our new office at Lawrence House.
