**Many children who have dyslexia also struggle with maths. This free workshop will offer useful information and ideas to help you support your child at home.**

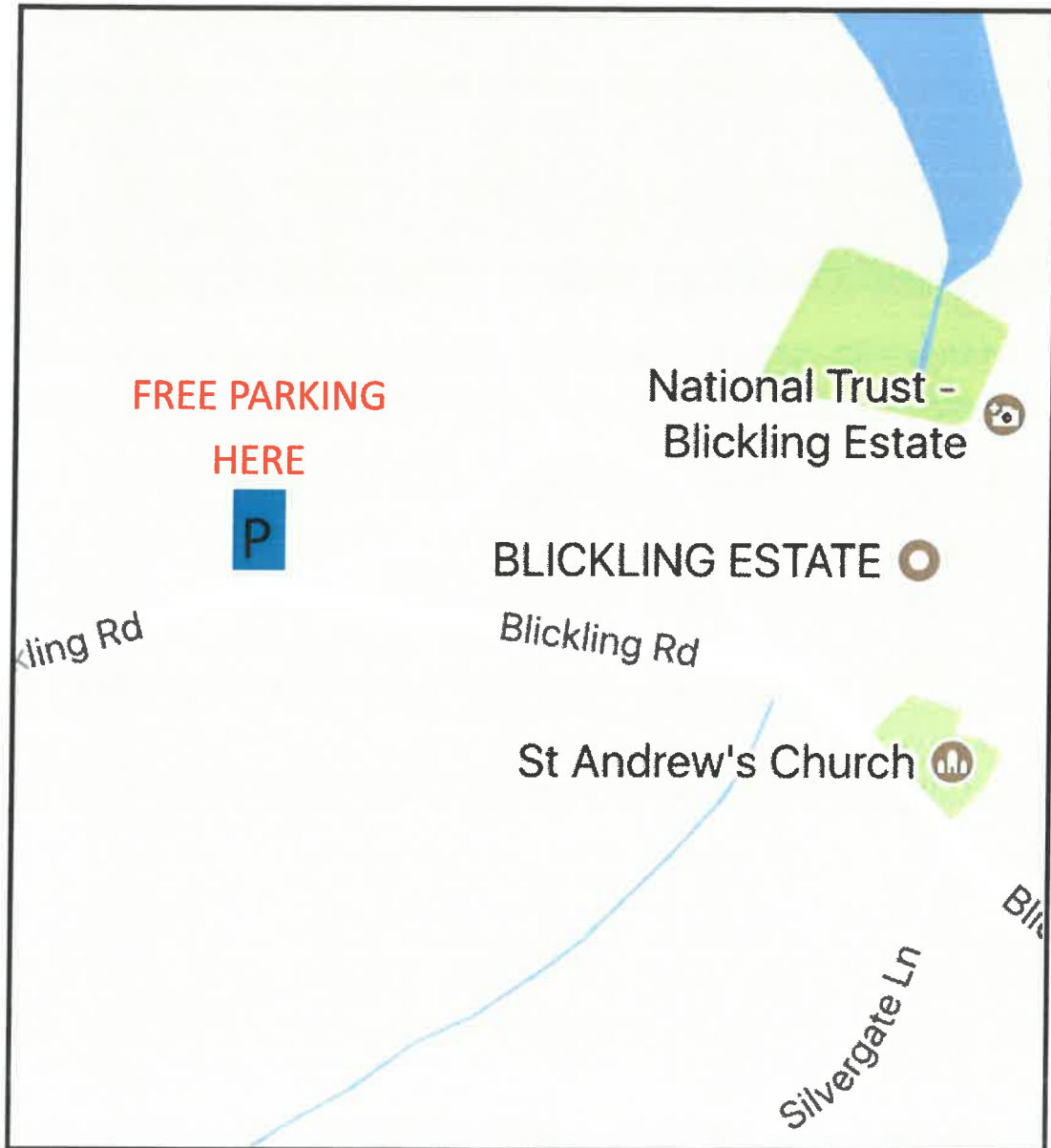
