support your child at home.**

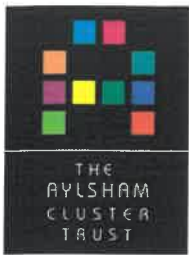
**During the workshop we will look at the types of challenges a

**You will receive some useful resources and handouts.**

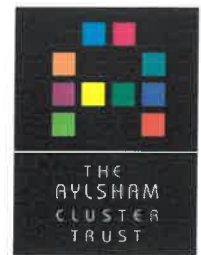
**This workshop has been specifically designed for anyone who

**Parenting isn't easy and sometimes things can get tough.  
As a parent/carer you want what is best for your child.**

**Our Parent Support Advisor is available to listen and support your family with any issues or concerns from home or school you may be facing.**

She may not have all of the answers, but she can offer:

- A confidential listening ear
- Help you to express your concerns about your child to the school and act as a link between school and home
- Offer support and advice if you have concerns about your child's social, emotional or behavioural development, so helping you to nip things in the bud before they get serious
- Support with transition – as they start or move between schools
- Give hints and tips about general parenting issues
- Help find services and other agencies who are available to help you and your family
- Help with issues around school attendance



## Norfolk Community Directory



The Local Offer website is made up of two parts, the first part are webpages containing information explaining what support is available for children and young people who have SEND and how this is accessed, along with information to support parent carers and guidance on preparing for adult life.

The second part is a searchable on-line directory of service providers ranging from childminders and after school clubs through to specialist short breaks providers and specialist support groups.

Together these describe the "Local Offer".

Norfolk County Council have just replaced the system which provides the on-line directory and this is now called the Norfolk Community Directory, it already contains over 3,500 services, but we know that they are many more groups and organisations that support and make their services accessible to children and young people with SEND.

To help make this a really great resource for families could you help us fill in the gaps?

If your child or young person goes to a really good club or group, that makes things accessible for them, see if they are on the directory, if they are not let us (Local Offer team) know and we will speak to the group organisers and help them get in the directory, so that more families can benefit from their service.
