## **1. IMPROVE ACHIEVEMENT FOR ALL PUPILS IN CORE SUBJECTS**

- We will arrange Learning Conversations in Autumn 2 for you to discuss your child's learning with their teacher
- Our teachers will use deeper questioning skills to further your child's learning
- We are going to look how we are teaching writing to ensure that it is engaging for your child and supports them to make good or better progress
- In EYFS and KS1 we will be looking at how we teach and monitor phonics to help your child spell

## 2. IMPROVE QUALITY OF TEACHING

- Our learning objectives and how the children will achieve them will be clear through our success criteria on stickers in the children's books
- We will be looking at Science for all children in our schools to see the impact of Science teaching over the year
- When doing our learning walks, all staff will look to see higher order questioning on learning stickers and in marking
- You will see in your child's books suggestions of how to improve work and opportunities for children to draft and re-do pieces of work

### 3. BEHAVIOUR AND SAFETY OF CHILDREN

- We will be looking at the effect Nurture has been having on our children and we will gather you views in this term
- Different children and classes/year groups will access nurture outdoor learning in order to practise skills for nurture and self esteem
- Continuing on from parent consultations last year, staff will make decisions about our behaviour policy, this will be launch soon
- The school will train two members of staff in keeping children safe in our schools

### 4. LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

- The governors will be presented with data of how many children are making the expected standard at different points through the year. They will ask questions about what they find
- All action plans for different areas of the curriculum will be written from a big document that shows our schools' strengths and weaknesses
- A new senior leadership team will be formed to ensure monitoring of the schools' progress throughout the year
