### Working Memory

On Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> November Aylsham High School are holding a FREE workshop from 9.30 - 11.45am. During this workshop they will explore what working memory is, as well as ways for you to support your child with their working memory skills to help increase their confidence and ability when reading, writing, doing arithmetic or studying for exams. Working memory problems are common in specific learning differences such as dyslexia, dyscalculia and ADHD. There will be useful resources and handouts for you to take home. This free workshop has been designed for anyone who has contact with a child of school age who has difficulties with working memory e.g. parents/carers, grandparents or other family members and will be delivered by our Dyslexia Outreach Service.
