Head Lice

We have had several cases of head lice reported to the office. Please check your child's hair daily in order to eradicate the problem. There is no intervention available from the school nurse as this is not something they offer, but if you need help please see staff in school.

The most effective way of getting rid of head lice is to use a special comb and comb through hair every day when they come home. You need to include all member of the family, adults and children. You can also buy lotions that will kill the lice but are expensive.
