## 1. IMPROVE ACHIEVEMENT FOR ALL PUPILS IN CORE SUBJECTS

- We will arrange Learning Conversations in Spring 2 for you to discuss your child's learning with their teacher
- Our teachers will be continuing to use deeper questioning skills to further your child's learning Introduce whole class guided reading sessions to focus on vocab and structure of texts
- We will invite EYFS and KS1 parents to a workshop to help you support your children with their phonics learning, the books they bring home will be specially selected to support this learning



## 2. IMPROVE QUALITY OF TEACHING

- Teachers will be using a new tracking system to monitor your child's progress
- Science teaching and learning will be focussed on investigations and we will continue with our SAW days
- When looking at evidence in books, teachers will be looking to see hta all children are challenging themselves and that learning is matched to their ability
- Writing across all subjects such as Theme will be of the same standard as in their English books



## 3. BEHAVIOUR AND SAFETY OF CHILDREN

- We will be looking at the effect Nurture has been having on our children and we will gather you views in this term
- Different children and classes/year groups will access nurture outdoor learning in order to practise skills for nurture and self esteem
- The new behaviour policy will be launched and we will be seeking your views on its impact in our schools
- We will be running online safety training to enable you to protect your children at home using our updated policy to support this

## 4. LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT

- The governors will be presented with data of how many children are making the expected standard at different points through the year. They will ask questions about what they find
- Children will be tested termly using a new set of test materials purchased by the school
- Time will be given to senior leaders of different areas of the curriculum to monitor how well it is being delivered in classes
