# WELCOME

If you wish for your child to attend and leave an activity without an adult, the council will require written permission from the parent/carer stating this intention before the date of the relevant activity.

**Please note children may only be registered and dropped off from 10 minutes before the start of the session.**

To be eligible to attend sessions, children must live or go to school in the Broadland District Council area.

### **Midnight**

Wednesday 19th February, 2.30pm

In the hours when most people are tucked up, sound asleep in their beds, Midnight the cat rules the roost. She explores the rooftops and alleyways of her town, encountering all the other creatures that are awake in the night. And in the still, quiet moments between one day finishing and the next one beginning, she has the ability to see and understand all the dreams of the people sleeping in their beds below.

But when a wild wind blows through the town, strange things begin to happen.

Combining beautiful puppetry, music and storytelling, Midnight is a dream-like show about time, the night and dreaming. It's also about clever cats and really silly dogs.

Martin Bridle and Su Eaton have woven extra drama and humour into the well-loved tale of Goldilocks, stitching together traditional glove puppetry and live music to create a patchwork of delights which is not too salty, not too sweet... but just right!
