## First Admission to School

As we are part way through the application process for the First Admission to school for the school year 2021/22, It is very important that's parents make their application to their Local Authority by 15 January 2021. The local authority wrote to parents at the end of September inviting them to make an application.

Children born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017 are due to start school in Reception in the school year starting September 2021. Parents will need to make application, even if their child currently attends a nursery class.
