Welcome to the October Half Term Tots2Teens brochure which offers a wide range of activities to keep young people entertained during the school holidays.

We welcome registrations from all our communities. If you require any special assistance please call us to discuss.

We offer a 50% reduction on all activities for Broadland households claiming Council Tax reduction, Housing Benefit or having housing costs met through Universal Credit.

Payment must be made by credit or debit card at the time of booking. **All fees are non-refundable, unless we are able to fill the space.**

If you wish for your child to attend and leave an activity without an adult, the council will require written permission from the parent/carer stating this intention before the date of the relevant activity.

Please note children may only be registered and dropped off from 10 minutes before the start of the session.

To be eligible to attend sessions, children must live or go to school in the Broadland District Council area.
