Supersonic Phonics Friends

The children started doing phonics daily at the beginning of term and they have taken it on brillaintly. The aim of phonics for the children while in nursery is to develop their listening skill, undertand rhythm and rhyme, alliteration and to begin oral belnding and segmenting. These are all of the skills they need before they can move onto looking at the shapes of letters and begin learning the phonetic sounds. The children spend 5 - 10 minutes a day completeing little activities, they've shown lots of interest in one activity called 'Listening Len has a Box'. These activitie will be uploaded onto tapestry for you to access at home.

We held our first Phonic Café and we would like to say thank you to those who joined us for this. We will be holding more of these over the school year.



Pantosaurus

There is never a wrong time to teach the children about how to keep themselves safe, at nursery we have been watching the NSPCC Pantosaurus video and learning about how to keep ourselves safe.

We have spoken about the PANTS rules, which are:

- P privates are private
- A always remember your body belongs to you
- N no means NO
- T talk about secrets that upset you
- S speak up, someone can help
