School Dinners

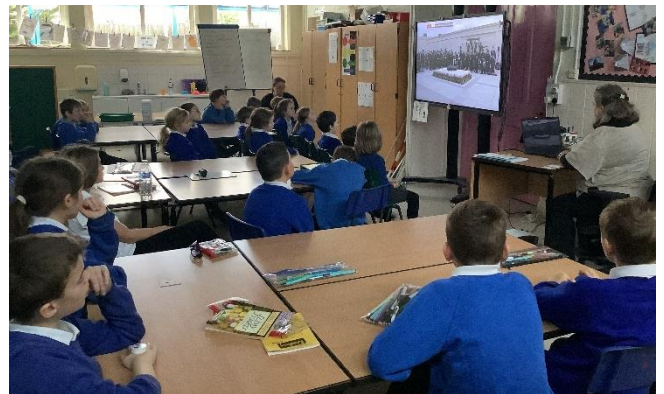
