World Book Day

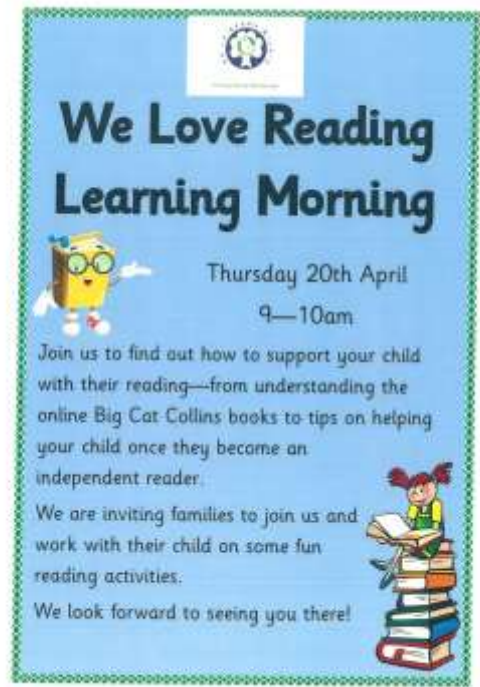
On World Book Day the Friend of Hevingham raised £70 from book sales on the day. Well done to everyone involved and who helped.
