PSHE and RSHE:

The Y1 children will be joining Mr Tate on Friday afternoons. Their focus will be 'Friendship and feeling lonely.'

Hedgehog class will also come together for Circle Time twice a week where we will focus on emotions and relationships. We will also all be continuing our work on Online Safety.

Theme (History):

This half term the children will be learning about the reign of Queen Elizabeth II, the origins of the royal family and the Battle of Hastings (this will cross over into art).

In Year 1, their knowledge of the Royal Family will then be transferred to their English focus for the end of term.

Creative Arts (Art and Design, Design and Technology, Music):
