

This is offered as a free to attend workshop on Thursday 25th April, 12.30 pm - 2.45 pm.

The workshop will help those attending to gain:

- a great understanding of what dyslexia is.
- knowledge of how dyslexia can affect a young person in their learning

- knowledge of how to help at home if their child has difficulties with literacy
