

English:

- First, we will be finishing our work on fables, writing our own narratives.
- Next, we will linking our English to our theme about rainforests. We will be looking at poetry with a rainforest theme and writing our own poems. We will also be writing adventure stories set in a rainforest. Our guided reading text is 'The Vanishing Rainforest.'

Maths:

- We start with some more fractions work, calculating fractions of quantities.
- In measures work, we will learn about perimeter. We will recap converting between units of measure
- We will learn properties and names of 2D shapes including different quadrilaterals. We will use co-ordinates.

Science:

- This half term we will be continuing our topic on sound. We will be learning about changing the pitch of sound. Then we will be planning an investigation onto muffling sound.
- After this, our next topic is all about plants. We will investigate what plants need to grow and survive. We will also look at the structure of a plant and function of the parts.

RE:

- In RE lessons, we will be looking at how religious groups contribute to society. We will find out the meaning of compassion and how individuals and groups might show compassion.
