

English:

In Drawing Club this half term, we will be going on lots of exciting adventures with books! The books we share together will focus on a wide range of cultures and communities. We will be challenging the children to begin writing short sentences as independently as they can.

We are nearing the end of Basics 3 phonics so will be moving on to Basics 4, concentrating on improving our blending and segmenting skills.

Maths:

Our focus this half term will be on exploring number bonds to 5 and then 10. We will use a variety of practical resources to practise making 5 and then 10 in different ways before developing our recall of these key number facts.

Understanding The World:

As part of our "All About Us" theme, we will be learning lots about other countries, cultures and communities around the world. We will talk about the things we notice and any similarities and differences that we spot. We will also look at lives in the past, making comparisons to our own lives.

Communication and Language:

We always ensure to make lots of time for talk in Hedgehog class! In our weekly circle times, we always make the time to talk about how we are feeling and to share any exciting news from home. Adults continue to engage in and model high quality interactions.
