English:

Narrative – based on the Anglo-Saxon legend of Beowulf. We will read parts of the story and think about the characters. We will be writing in role as characters as well as writing dialogue between two characters.

Poetry – looking at Anglo-Saxon poetry.

Discussion texts – we will learn about discussion writing and studying example texts. We will practise the grammar features before writing our own discussion texts on the theme of Anglo-Saxons and Vikings - Heroes or Villains?

Maths:

Measures – recapping different units of measurement and converting between them. Telling the time. Applying learning to solving problems.

Shape and Position – recapping the names and properties of different shapes including different quadrilaterals and triangles. Manipulating shapes on co ordinate grids.

Statistics and Data – different types of graphs and charts and how to read information from them including pictograms, bar charts, and tables.

Science:

This half term's topic is 'Animals including Humans'. This involves learning about nutrition and what animals need to eat to survive. We will learn about food groups. We will then move on to learning about the skeleton and muscles in ourselves and other animals.

RE:

 Our big question is 'What is Sacrifice?'. We will look at the meaning of sacrifice and examples of both religious and non-religious sacrifices that are made. We will learn about Muslim sacrifice during Ramadan, Christian views about Jesus' sacrifice, and Humanist sacrifices



Summer term 2 - 2025 'Heroes and Villains' Badger Class

PSHE and RSHE:

- We will be thinking about when we might need help to manage a situation and the skills we need for this.
- As we approach the end of the year, we will also think about changes and transition to next year.

Theme (History or Geography):

 This half term the theme is 'Heroes and Villains' and within this, we will be finding out about the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. We will find out where they came from, and the reasons. We will learn about the struggle for power between different tribes, kingdoms and leaders. We will also study artefacts and draw conclusions.
