

English:

We will be continuing to work hard on developing our writing skills, working specifically on composing and writing short sentences. Our phonics focus will remain on learning to read and write longer words, such as "camp" and "sink". Remember to use the weekly phonics newsletters to help support your child at home! We will also continue to expose children to a variety of texts, developing and supporting their opinion and to begin to compare texts during our daily story time.

Maths:

This half term, we will be developing fluency with number. Quick recall of key number facts will help the children with their reasoning and problem solving skills. We will focus specifically on number bonds and subtraction facts to 5 and then 10 before moving on to doubling and halving. At home, games are a great way to support your child's understanding of number - especially if there are points to be totalled and compared!

Understanding The World:

We will continue to look at and explore the world around us while introducing the children to some new and exciting vocabulary. As the weather brightens, we have been planting and weeding in the garden and this is something we will continue over the coming weeks. We will also be exploring life in the past and life in other cultures through lots of high quality stories and non-fiction books. We can't wait to talk about all of our favourite fictional and real life heroes (and villains too)!

Communication & Language:

In our last term, we will nurture and encourage children to explain the world around them. Using their knowledge, we will begin to challenge the children more extensively to explain and make predictions. We will continue to develop and expand vocabulary and model correct tenses when appropriate on a 1:1 need.
