

English:

- English lessons will be linked to our history work on Ancient Egypt. We will be studying the story 'Egyptian Cinderella'. We will compare versions, carry out drama work and write our own versions.
- We will also learn about instruction writing and create a set of instructions for mummification.

Maths:

- We will begin with place value work, working with three and four digit numbers – ordering, comparing and placing on number lines.
- We will also be working on addition and subtraction using the formal column methods. We will build up to applying these methods to problems.

Science:

- This half term our topic is 'Living things and their habitats.' We will learn about plants and animals in the locality and how they can be classified into different groups. We will learn to use identification keys. We will also think about the impact of changes to an environment and how this affects the living things.

RE:

- In RE lessons, we will be thinking about how people express commitment to a religion. This will involve finding out more about different ceremonies including those from Hindu and Sikh faiths.

- This half term's PSHE work will begin with deciding upon and writing our new class agreement. We will think about class roles and responsibilities including School Council.
