English:

- We will start the term with book week, exploring the book 'The Lost Words' by Robert MacFarlane.
- We will then look at the book 'Cakes in Space' by Phillip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre
- Poetry will link to 'Pass the Jam Jim'
- Guided reading 'Jampires' by Sarah McIntyre and David O'Connell

Maths:

 We will start by exploring fractions and amounts before moving into measuring, shape and position, and statistics and data.

Science:

YR2 - CREST Award activities

The children will explore different CREST award challenge cards, devising and performing different experiments before analysing and interpreting their findings.

RE:

 This half term the focus will be on preparing for our school nativity. They will use it to gather knowledge and understanding about the Christmas story in preparation to help answer next half terms question 'What does the nativity story teach Christians about Jesus?'

PSHE and RSHE:

 We will be looking at feelings and behaviours (Unit 3) and Self-control & anger management (Unit 4).

They will learn to understand that they have some control over their actions and bodies, and to recognise different types of teasing and bullying, understanding that these are wrong and unacceptable.

Theme (History or Geography):

 We have a Geography focus, learning about the United Kingdoms four capital cities, London, Cardiff, Edinburgh and Belfast. We will learn key facts about each and compare.
