

### English:

- We will finish off 'Ocean Meets Sky' from last half term before creating non-chronological reports on **Queen Elizabeth II** and writing a narrative based on **The Battle of Hastings**, linking with our history topic.
- Guided reading – we will explore the book 'The Conquerors' by David McKee

### Maths:

- We will be spending a good amount of time looking at different methods to answer calculations/algebra, moving on to areas of focus based on last terms tests.
- We will be refining and consolidating written methods, exploring and investigating.

### Science: Plants

- We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

### RE:

- In RE, the children will look at, and explore, the question 'How do Jewish people celebrate Passover (Pesach)?'

### PSHE and RSHE:

They will be looking at 'Manners and listening to others (Unit 7). They will learn:

- That animals including humans, grow and reproduce.
- That humans and animals can produce offspring and these grow into adults
- To recognise how they grow and will change as they become older (not including puberty process)

We will also continue to look at our current online safety knowledge and work on ways to improve it.

### Theme (History or Geography):

- We have a **history** focus this half term, learning about **the reign of Queen Elizabeth II, the origins of our royal family, and The Battle of Hastings**
- We hope to take part in reenactments and link it into our English writing.

### Creative Arts (Art and Design, Design and Technology, Music):

- This half term we have an **Art focus of drawing** and we will link it in with our Battle of Hastings topic, exploring the Bayeux Tapestry.
- In **music** we will be looking at the Sing-up sessions based around 'The Rockpool Rock'.

### Other Subjects:

In computing we will be looking at **digital music.**
