**Swimming Gala**

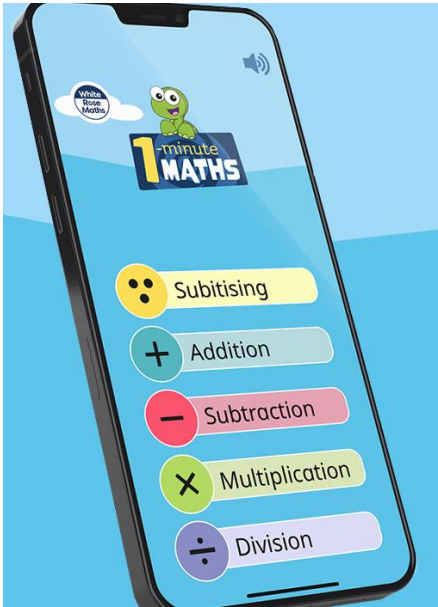

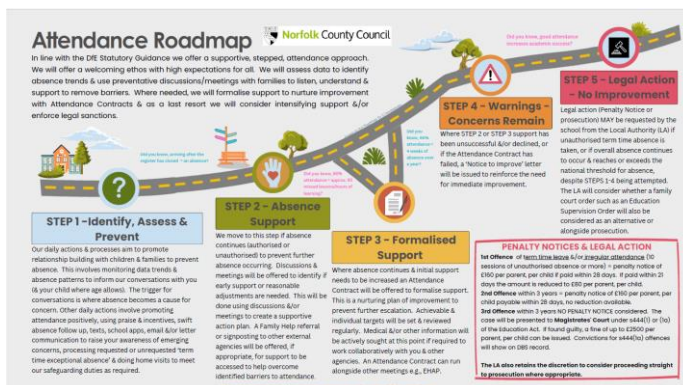
